

**CREATIVE WRITING** A workshop, held fortnightly. For beginners and advanced, these classes will use a variety of ideas to set you writing. We will focus on the short story and script writing, this is an opportunity to find and develop your individual style of self-expression in a supportive atmosphere

**POTTERY** Coiling, slab building, throwing on the wheel, glazes and firing in our own kiln. Beginners are welcome. Get stuck in and grasp the undoubtedly therapeutic aspects of handling the clay and working the artistry of glazes!

Fridays £90 for 10 weeks

**PATCHWORK, QUILTING & APPLIQUÉ** Techniques and traditional patterns taught, for quilts, cushions and gift ideas such as boxes and cards! Your own designs encouraged, with wonderful results. All levels welcome.  
Mondays £75 for 10 weeks

**ART - WATER COLOURS** Colours, sketches and washes abound, with the opportunity to sometimes paint in The Guildhouse itself, and outside in the gardens and experience the panoramic views. For beginners and improvers.  
Fridays £80 for 10 weeks

**WOODWORK** Beginners select simple projects then learn the basics of design, marking, sawing, planing and joining and the use and care of tools. The more experienced also receive individual tuition and advice for their chosen projects and **MARQUETRY**: Using wood veneers to create patterns and pictures.  
Tuesdays £110 for 2.5hrs class Wednesdays £132 for 3hrs class

**WOODCARVING** A wonderfully creative, expressive and precise art. Coaching for traditional and abstract forms, learning to work with natural wood and work with its qualities. Teaching includes care of chisels and shaping tools  
Mondays £90 (10 weeks) and Wednesdays £99 (11 weeks)

**WOODTURNING** Learn how to craft woods to full advantage and produce a wonderful range of exquisite everyday and unique items on the lathes. *NB: students must help tidy/straighten up on all messier courses!*  
Monday eves £100 (10 wks) Tues eves £110 for 2.5hrs class. Tuesdays & Wednesdays £132 for 3hrs class (11 weeks)

**FURNITURE RESTORATION** Bring a small piece of furniture (no storage available) and learn the restoration techniques of identifying and detailing the piece, dismantling and repairing, then more specialised skills of stripping, re-polishing and/or French polishing.  
Tuesdays £132 for 11 weeks

#### **STAINED GLASS AND KILN FIRED GLASS**

Make stained glass pieces using traditional techniques for cutting glass, leading, soldering to produce an individual panel! Beginners and improvers welcome. Kiln fired glass ~ create designed pieces using colour and texture, learning to incorporate diverse materials. Your panels are then kiln-fired and the results themselves can be put to great effect, for practical use, art or gift ideas. Beginners welcome. Please see notes about materials overleaf.

**A DAY PAINTING ON REFLECTION** A one-day workshop exploring painting reflections. Working from still life or from photographs (all supplied) we will spend the day looking at the way we represent reflected objects in still life and explore how to make reflected images in the landscape convincing. For beginners and improvers. You can work in any medium -Oil, Acrylic, Watercolour, Gouache or Pastel. You will need to supply your own materials. Tea, coffee and lunch provided.

**FELTMAKING** Learn how to make handmade felt items such as scarves, jewellery, bags, slippers and wall hangings. Feltmaking is a tactile, rewarding technique where beautiful textiles can be created very quickly from wool and other fibres. I will help you make both traditional and innovative felt during the course. Beginners are welcome. Materials can be bought from the tutor; typical costs would be £2 for a scarf, £8 for a pair of slippers.
