HOW TO GET HERE!

Stanton is a small village 2.5 miles south of Broadway, just off the B4632 Broadway to Winchcombe/Cheltenham road.

From Evesham take the A44 Evesham to Oxford road and continue to Broadway. Turn onto the B4632 towards Winchcombe. Continue until you see the sign for Stanton which is about the 6th turning on the left. Continue into the village until after a right bend. Immediately turn left *and continue until the road narrows. This length of the road is 2-way so proceed cautiously. Go straight on up the hill and past the Mount Inn pub. Continue on through the pub's lower car park and on through the 5-bar gateway into the Guildhouse grounds. On your right is our main car park but you can continue on up to the House to unload. Those with walking difficulties have priority to leave their vehicles here.

From the M5 leave at Junc 9 (Tewkesbury) and from Stow-on-the-Wold take the B4077. Both these roads converge at the Toddington Roundabout (shop on corner) and where the B4632 'Broadway' exit should be taken. Continue until the Stanton turning on the right. This takes you through the village main street. Continue until the road turns sharply left. At this point turn right – any traffic from your left has priority- then continue following the directions given from the * above.

DICK ONIANS, M.A. (CANTAB)

Dick is an Associate of the Royal Society of British Sculptors and a senior carving tutor at the City & Guilds of London Art School. For over thirty years he has had wide experience of teaching traditional and modern sculpture and has carried out original commissions for clients both in this country and abroad. A number of these works have been for public display. As well as his teaching he has been engaged in writing numerous articles for the Woodcarving Press and is also currently engaged with writing his third book which will deal with stone carving. Dick was awarded a gold medal for teaching by the City and Guilds of London Institute and was the first recipient of the President's (the Duke of Edinburgh's) award for teaching carving.

THE COURSE

This is our Twentieth year and our 36th summer school! Beginners and the more experienced alike come to work side by side in an environment where it is possible to learn, exchange ideas, explore styles traditional, modern and abstract and to be inspired by the ambience, the beauty of the environment, the teaching and the company of sympathetic people.

When not carving you can relax in the house; walk in the surrounding countryside; visit the craft centres, villages and places of interest nearby; or just stroll down to the pub and enjoy a drink while looking over the Vale of Evesham to the Malverns and the Welsh hills.

All local information is available in the house.

PRACTICALITIES

Cost - £435.00

This includes tuition plus home cooked lunch each day and all tea and coffee breaks. Dinner is available at £18.00 per evening. This includes a complimentary glass of wine.

ACCOMMODATION – A limited amount is available in the Guildhouse, on a first come first served basis. Full Board in the Guildhouse is £725.00, including tuition, lunch and supper. This includes linen, towels and continental breakfast. Further accommodation can be arranged in the village of Stanton or its surroundings in recommended B+B's.

EQUIPMENT – Tools can be borrowed by prior arrangement for a fee of £3 and students should generally provide their own materials. Information on what should be brought can be provided with the confirmation of booking.

WHEN – The course is from Wednesday 30th August until Wednesday 6th September. Arrival should be for tea at 5pm with dinner being served at 7pm. Departure is after lunch on Wednesday 6th September at 2.30pm.

TEACHING - This starts each day at 9.30am and continues until 6pm with breaks throughout the day for lunch, coffee, tea and cakes.
